## A, B, C's of The Pesach Retreat

**Accessibility:** The entire hotel is wheelchair/handicap accessible.

Air Conditioning: The air conditioning unit fitted in your room is located on the wall next to your bed. Each room has its own temperature control system which allows you to increase or decrease the temperature in your room according to your own level of comfort. It is recommended that you keep your windows and doors closed for the air-conditioning to be effective.

**Airport Transfers:** If you require shuttle transportation from or to the airport, please let us know. Travel time is approximately 45 minutes to OR Tambo JHB Intl Airport without traffic. Lanseria Airport is closer by and worthwhile for domestic travel.

**Babysitting:** Please inquire at Reception to book babysitting.

**Bakwena Spa**: For all your pampering! Visit the reception desk for more info. Please note that any food/drink served in the Spa is prepared in an external kitchen and IS NOT kosher for Pesach.

**Boxed Lunches**: For guests going on our Chol HaMoed excursions, boxed lunches or snacks will be provided for you. For guests going on their own day trips, pre-ordered boxed lunches will be ready and waiting in the dining room on the requested day. All take-away lunches must be ordered one day in advance. Please order at the reception desk. There is no charge for these boxed meals.

Candle Lighting: Candles for Shabbos and Yom Tov candle lighting will be set up in the Dining Halls. See the schedule for exact candle lighting times. It is most important, for everyone's safety, that you do not light candles in your room!

**Cell Phones:** The primary networks in South Africa include Vodacom, Cell C, MTN and 8ta. You can purchase airtime in voucher form from any corner shop, supermarket, or cellular network store.

**Check-In**: General Check-in starts on March 30<sup>th</sup> at 14:00. Please find your name and room key in the reception area. You may want to obtain extra keys so one can be left in the light-switch in your room during Shabbos/Yom Tov. During the course of the day, please be sure to

chat with reception so that they can take any more details, as well as record your credit card number for any incidentals.

**Check-Out:** All guests must check out at the reception desk before departure. If you are departing during *Chol HaMoed*, we welcome you to remain and enjoy breakfast. Your room must be vacated and keys returned to reception by 11:00am to avoid additional charge.

Children's Programmes: The Kids Den is located in the Velmoré hotel building on the ground level. Supervised children programming will be offered daily by well-equipped counselors. Details on times and location are included later in this booklet. See the bulletin computer for updated schedules. The Kids Den equipped with toys and games will be open every day of the retreat.

**Clothing:** Temperatures can drop quickly in the evenings and early mornings (10-20° Celsius) so we do suggest packing your clothing accordingly. Generally a sweater or light jacket will suffice at this time of year.

**Coffee & Tea Room:** Coffee and Tea will be available all day, with delectable refreshments added at Tea time, in the XO Bar Cafe.

**Cutlery and Crockery**: Please do not take any cutlery or crockery out of the dining room for any reason. Should you require some for use elsewhere please ask us, and disposable items can be provided.

**Damages:** Please look after this facility, and ensure that children respect the property. Any damages caused by guests will be charged to the guest accordingly.

**Donations:** If you have pledged a donation at Shul please make payments to The Miracle Drive Trust: Account number: 62457937989 FNB Balfour Park – Branch: 250-655 Ref: your name. Your contribution will be designated to assist the elderly and other indigent people in our community. Please email proof of contributions to <u>rak@chabad.org.za</u>. We thank you for your generous support!

**Drinking Water:** The tap water in this area is clean, fresh, and fit to drink!

**Electricity Supply:** All electric outlets in your room are off when your room key card is not inserted in the control box. We recommend that you request an additional key card to preset which lights you wish to stay on during Yom Tov or charge any appliances, please ask at Reception. All outlets provide 220 volts.

Emergencies/Illness: In the event of an emergency, call 082911. Be prepared to state the nature of the problem and your location. Internally, dial 9 to reach reception to notify staff of any urgent situation. For minor medical issues, first aid kits are available at the reception desk. To reach Police, call 10111. If you travel to the Johannesburg area and encounter an emergency; for medical emergencies call Hatzolah at 083-222-1818. For any other type of emergency call CSO at 086-18-000-18. If you are stuck anywhere, call "Dial a Menths" at 081-818-1818. These private services do not extend to the area of the hotel.

**Excursions:** We have organized trips for each day of Chol HaMoed including the Lion Park, Pilansberg Game Reserve, Gold Reef City, Sterkfontein Caves and more. We are happy to organize additional excursions based on guest request. Please keep abreast via the WhatsApp group or approach any of us directly. Buses for day trips will depart from the front entrance parking area of the hotel. Departure will be promptly at the stated departure time.

**Elevator/Lift:** There will be staff stationed on each floor to assist with elevators and room keys during Shabbos and Yom Tov days/nights.

**Eruv:** The Eruv allows you to carry between rooms and anywhere within the hotel perimeter including the pool area up until the river. The Eruv does not extend outside the hotel property. The Eruv has been coordinated with the Beth Din dayanim and Dubi Barlev.

**Food:** Please help us maintain our strictest Pesach kashrus. All your meals, snacks, and beverages are provided. Outside food, if not labeled with a reliable Pesach Kashrus standard, is not allowed in any of the common areas at all.

**Games:** There are board games available from reception for your enjoyment.

**Gymnasium:** The gym is equipped with various pieces of equipment. For safety reasons, guests under the age of 16 must be accompanied by

an adult to use the gym. Please collect gym key at the Reception desk.

Hashgacha/Kashrus: Our programme is under the strict rabbinical supervision of the Johannesburg Beth Din guaranteeing the highest level of kashrus standards. The kitchen is completely koshered for Pesach with constant supervision of the mashaichim.

**Keys:** As all the room keys are electronic, there will be staff members stationed on each floor or at reception to help with room entry on all Shabbos and YomTov days/nights.

**Kitchen:** Please do not enter the kitchen for any reason. Should you have a request, please ask the waiting staff or *mashqichim*.

**Lost & Found:** The 'Lost and Found' is located at the reception. Please be sure to leave found items or check for lost items at this location.

**Luggage Service:** Luggage assistance is available to all guests at arrival and departure.

Massage Therapy: Please see the Spa brochure at reception. Appointments can be made at check-in and throughout the week at the reception desk.

**Meals:** Please see schedule and bulletin boards to know where each meal is taking place. On Yom Tov and Shabbos, Kiddush will take place in the dining areas.

**Medical:** For emergencies please see 'Emergencies' above. First aid kits are available at the reception desk.

**Mikvah:** There are multiple mikvahs in Johannesburg. Please speak with Rebbetzin Batya Kievman for information. Alternatively you can visit our website to locate, and make an appointment at, the Mikvah of your choice. Men, please feel free to use the pool discretely and safely.

**Parking:** Parking bays are available for all guests in the front entrance of the hotel, free of charge.

**Reception Desk:** Our reception desk is located in the Velmoré Grande building and will be staffed 24/7. The reception desk phone number is 012 370 7000 or 9 from a hotel landline. Here you will be able to check the daily schedule, report maintenance issues,

add/change excursion reservations, order boxed meals, ask for any assistance, and generally have your questions answered.

**Refrigerator:** A refrigerator is available in each room for any personal items that need refrigeration.

Running/Walking off property: If you intend to run or walk on the road outside of the hotel, please take security precautions. The area immediately around the hotel does not have regular security patrols. Run/walk with a partner and remain aware of your surroundings.

**Safety:** If you are visiting this country it behooves you to be aware of security precautions. These include being aware of your surroundings, knowing your direction and destination, refraining from wearing flashy jewelry, and keeping car windows securely closed.

Seders: Seders will take place in the Banquet Halls adjacent to the Shul and will be set before you arrive from Shul. Seating charts will be posted to assist you in finding your spot. Seder plates and all objects are provided. If you have booked a private seder please locate your designated room

**Shul:** All Shul services are held in the Shul/Chapel. There will be signposts directing you to this location.

**Spa:** See Bakwena Spa

**Swimming:** Please feel free to use the pool on Chol Hamoed days. There is no lifeguard on duty. Please exercise standard water precautions and take care to mind the children.

**Transport:** Please liaise with reception if you require any transportation services. We will also be able to provide you with a list of Jewish drivers who are familiar with the Jewish community and your specific needs.

We will be able to provide transport with our Bus Mitzvah for certain organized excursions. Please inquire with Rabbi Kievman.

**Valuables:** Please take every measure to look after your valuables. The Pesach Retreat is not responsible for any missing or lost items.

**Wi-Fi:** All guests have access to the hotel's free wireless Internet service. Click on Velmoré Secure from the wireless networks and use the password VelmorE2018.


